MyData Online 2020 (Dec 10-12) will gather 1000 personal data professionals and people interested in the data economy.


We bring together **business**, **legal**, **tech and societal perspectives** to create sustainable, fair and prosperous digital society.

Our virtual venue: QiqoChat

- QiqoChat is a "social wrapper" built around Zoom (online video meeting room) to ensure the freedom of movement, exactly the same way as in the regular conference.
- Qiqo is a venue: it provides space for the conference. The audio and video for each of the session rooms is based on Zoom.
- This means that each of the session has its dedicated Zoom call.
 Each of the Zoom calls needs a host to e.g. record the session.
- There are also social spaces, rooms to relax in and Gardens.

Dear Volunteers-to-be.

Working in an online event requires:



- Foolproof as the default setting for any guidance or instructions
- Focus on easy navigation, helping people to find the right places, the right sessions, the right people
- "Keep calm and..." Stressful incidents are going to come up, so staying calm and assuring people that everything is under control or taken care of is very important
- People don't interact naturally online so special care should be put to this - inviting people to chat, to interact, to be active, to goof around a bit











And avoiding the worst case scenario....

- Frantic participants and presenters
- Connections, buttons, other things not working

- People not learning to navigate the venue
- People feel the event structure too heavy or complex to understand to gain the most out of the conference
